SHORT COURSES

OBJÈTS DE FELT: FELTMAKING

FOR THE FIRST SESSION STUDENTS SHOULD BRING:

- 2/3 old towels
- a plastic jug (not metal or glass)
- 2/3 thin supermarket carriers
- a pair of old tights or pop socks
- medium size sharp scissors

YOU'RE FIRED! BONE CHINA

There will be an extra £10 charge for materials\*, to be paid on first session. Please bring:

- Apron
- Sketchbook for inspiration
- Drawing media
- Paper

**\*Be aware that your ceramic transfers are an additional requirement and cost from £7**

BAWDY CORSETRY

There will be a small charge for materials that are not widely available from elsewhere, during the course... e.g. for bones and eyelets etc.

GLASS: SKETCH, ETCH & CAST:

Please bring drawing materials and glassware you wish to engrave on. There may be a small charge for materials that are not widely available from elsewhere during the course e.g. sheet glass. TOOLS will be provided for use during sessions.

FASHION JEWELLERY:

Findings and materials will be available to purchase from the Applied Arts shop during the course if required.

FASHION ILLUSTRATION:

Drawing tools including pencils and a sketchbook. Materials will be provided for first session.

## MASTERCLASSES

### RESIN -

Useful things to bring...Any small objects you would like to embed;

- Photographs, bits of collage
- Bits and bobs such as beads, buttons, ribbon, wire
- Pieces of embroidery or drawings
- Bring sketchbooks or journals for inspiration
- Jewellery findings (to attach to resin if you wish)
- Metal Modelling tools (if you have them)

### IMAGE TRANSFER & EMBELLISHMENT:

Please bring:

- 1 or 2 small photographs of interest to you personally (can be colour or black and white)
- Old shirt or overalls/apron
- rubber gloves
- optional but useful
  - o Embroidery threads and small scraps of fabric, braid, beads, ribbon etc for embellishing. If required you can purchase mixed bags of these from tutor at £5 per bag.

### BUTTONS AND BOBS:

Please bring:

- spare buttons, old button boxes
- haberdashery, threads etc.
- ribbons, trimmings, lace scraps
- fabric scraps
- hand sewing needles

DO YOUR BIT! - LEARN TO KNIT:

Please bring:

- Knitting needles
- Donated yarn will be provided but you may bring your own if you wish.

GLASS: ETCH & SKETCH:

Please bring:

- Drawing materials
- Glass to engrave e.g. vases, drinking/wine glasses, coasters etc. items will be available from the tutor at a small charge if you don't have anything suitable.
